Goals: The goal of the writers of the Articles was to create a loose union of states under a weak national government that would have authority over only a few things but would not have the ability or resources to enforce its decision and couldn't abuse its powers.

The document does not really talk about the United States as a nation but instead said, the states "enter into a firm league of friendship with each other, for their common defense...to assist each other [from]...all attacks made upon them."
